PERSONNEL:

SAFETY:

Monthly station audits were completed as part of the weekly duty schedule. Non-pharmaceutical interventions (NPIs) are in place at all stations. Closure of stations continues to the general public. A modified training plan remains in place. Phase 3 will allow up to 50% occupancy for all indoor spaces.
