Personnel:

The server provides the connection to Spillman CAD for the automatic download of call times and unit ID's to the EMS ePCR's. The annual cost for access is \$240.00. In the future, when the server reaches end of life, the City of Aberdeen will pay the full cost of replacement.

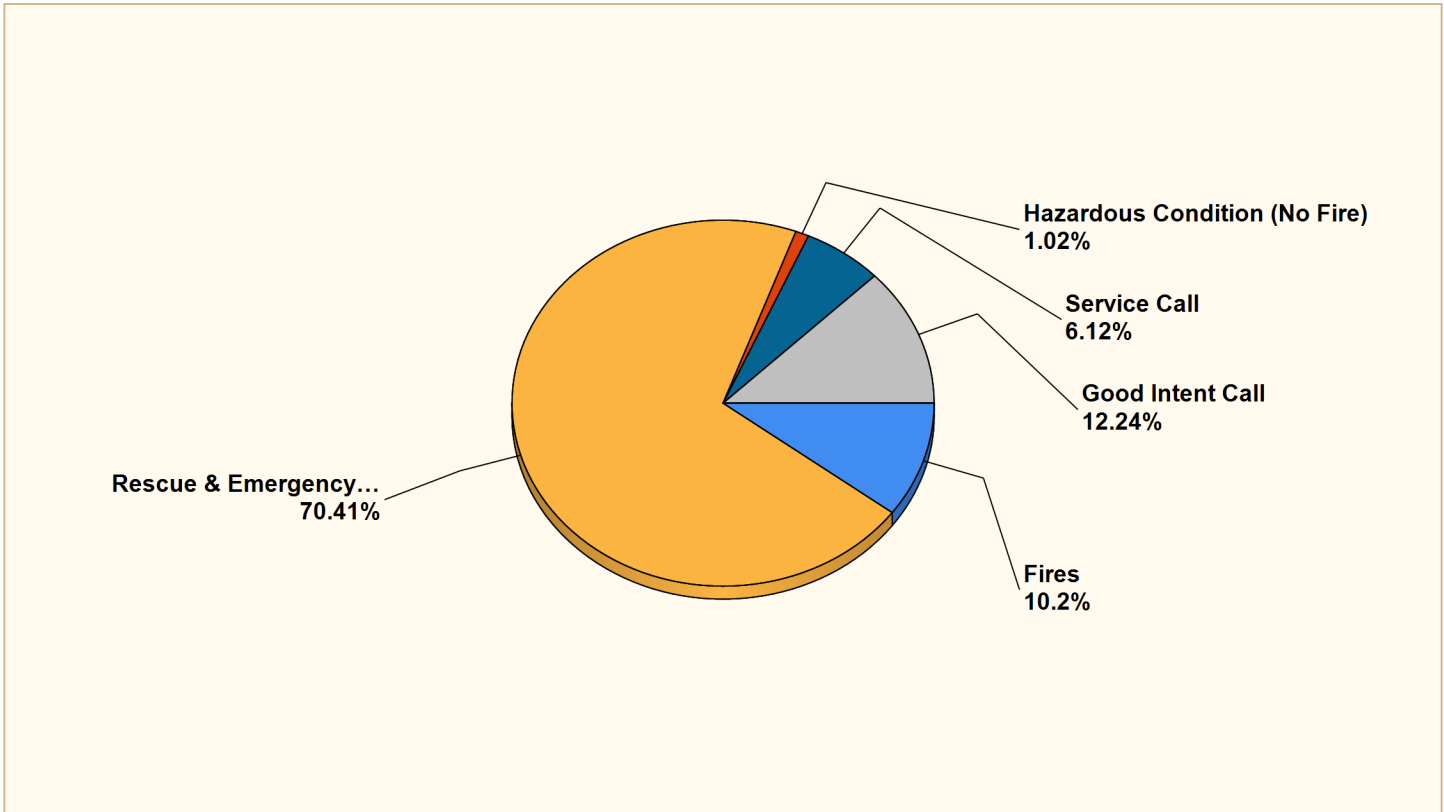
