### Personnel:

Chief McNutt's transition has progressed smoothly, and he is still working with all responders to evaluate where the department is and where it is headed. Chief's Interviews have been planned for the first full week in February for new recruits.

### Safety:

Chief McNutt attended the L&I FIIRE webinar presentation in January. A request for the quarterly survey of the program was received, and Chief McNutt spoke with L&I and is working with them to accomplish this survey after he has time to review the program started by Chief Hatley.
